Prof. Jeffrey Waincymer, Independent Arbitrator & Mediator

Prof. Waincymer is an independent arbitrator and mediator and also consults generally in the fields of international trade and investment, customs law and trade remedies. He is also currently an adjunct Professor at the Faculty of Law, National University of Singapore. He is on the HKIAC, SIAC, AIAC and ICDR arbitration panels and is an honorary Fellow of CIArb. Jeff was previously an Australian Government Nominee as a panelist for the WTO and ICSID. He has conducted pro bono legal capacity building in a range of developing countries and for a range of aid agencies. He is the author of *Procedure and Evidence in International Arbitration* (Kluwer); *WTO Litigation: Procedural Aspects of Formal Dispute Settlement* (Cameron May), and *Australian Income Tax: Principles and Policy* (2nd ed Butterworths) and a joint author of *A Guide to the New UNCITRAL Arbitration Rules* (Cambridge University Press), *A Practical Guide to International Commercial Arbitration* (Oceana) and *International Trade Law: Commentary and Materials* (2nd ed Law Book Company) as well as numerous scholarly articles.
